<u>I TO VIII</u>

<u>My Health My Right:</u> World Health Day is a global health awareness day, celebrated every year on 7th April. To guide the students about how to stay fit and healthy, an 'Eat Healthy and Stay Healthy' session will be conducted for classes I to VII on 6^{TH} APRIL 2024.

<u>Eid-ul-Fitr:</u>

- On the eve of Eid-ul-Fitr, to spread the message of love and brotherhood, a special assembly will be organised on **10th April 2024**. The participants will be informed separately by the activity in charge.
- The students will do arts & crafts activities related to the festival. The students will bring Eid special dishes in their tiffin boxes.

Baisakhi: To apprise students about the significant customs and traditions of Baisakhi, a special assembly will be conducted on **12th April 2024**. The students of Grades I & II will come to school in traditional Punjabi attire.

<u>Ram Navami</u>: To mark the birth anniversary of Lord Shree Rama a special assembly will be conducted on **16th April 2024.** The participants will be informed separately by the class teacher.

<u>World Heritage Day:</u> Heritage is our legacy from the past. Our culture and natural heritage are irreplaceable sources of life and inspiration. On World Heritage Day, the following competitions will be conducted on 18th April 2024.

Intra-Class Heritage Walk (I-II)

- Participants will come dressed up in the traditional attire of any of the Indian states.
- They will speak about the state they are representing.
- The judgement criteria will be based on the content, costume, confidence and expressions.

Intra-Class Heritage Quiz (III-VII)

- An Intra Class Heritage quiz will be conducted on **18th April 2024**.
- The theme for the competition will be Monuments and Sites.

Inter-House English Poem Recitation (I-VII) Recitation is one of the most important and effective modes of learning a language and appreciating a piece of literature. To explore the inner talent of students, an Inter-House English Poem Recitation competition will be conducted on 20th April 2024.

- Each contestant will be given 2-3 minutes to recite the poem.
- Self-introduction is a must before starting the poem.
- Participants can choose any one of the given themes i.e. Nature, Seasons, Friendship and Family.
- Contestants will be judged based on their actions, props, articulation, confidence and correct pronunciation.

Inter-House Poster-Making Competition (I-VII) To spread awareness of the health risks of plastics and to rapidly phase out all single-use plastics, an Inter-House Poster Making competition will be held on 22 April 2024.

- The theme for the competition will be **Planet vs Plastic.**
- The time limit will be 40 minutes.
- Judgement criteria will be theme relevance, creativity, neatness and overall visual presentation.

School Cabinet: The students' cabinet plays a major role in involving the students in day-to-day school activities and creating a sense of responsibility and leadership among them.

1. <u>Nomination round (24th April 2024)</u>

This round is mandatory for all the students of grades VI-VII.

Contestants will give their introduction and fill in nominations for the post they are contesting for. 2. <u>Interview Round (26th April 2024)</u>

Contestants will have a one-to-one interaction with the school principal.

3. <u>Manifesto Presentation (27th April 2024)</u> The shortlisted students from the interview round will present their manifesto.

4. <u>Campaigning (29th April 2024)</u>

Finalists will go for campaigning their objectives and ideas through posters or speeches.

5. <u>Elections for the School Cabinet (30th April 2024</u>)

The students from grades I to VII will vote in a secret ballot.
